



Type 7

Type 7 is used as a standard potting substrate for nursery plants like trees, shrubs and roses or conifers.

Type 7 offers the following advantages:

- great structural stability of the substrate and air capacity by the share of white peat and peat fibres
- high water retention and buffering capacity of pH-value by the balanced part of frozen black peat

Composition: 65 % white peat
15 % frozen black peat
20 % peat fibres
1500 g NPK- fertilizer /m³

Structure: medium coarse

Chemical values: pH-value: 5,0 - 5,5
(according to LUFA*) Salt content: 1,1 - 1,6 g/l
Nitrogen, N: 150 - 250 mg/l
Phosphorus, P₂O₅: 180 - 300 mg/l
Potassium, K₂O: 230 - 380 mg/l

We recommend **Type 7** for pots ≥ 12 cm.

Packing: bags 70 l, Maxi-Block 3,25 m³, in bulk (EN)
